How does timing work in Tarot

Often when we have a Tarot reading, just about everyone will want to know when the event predicted will happen – whether it is a new job, new love or any significant event will be turning up in our lives.

It is natural to want to know when but the Universe doesn't always want to tell us. Why? Maybe we are not supposed to know or maybe knowing will change or delay the outcome.

It's not always easy to have patience especially if we have waited for a long time already so let's take a look at how you can determine timing with the Tarot.

Each suit of the Tarot corresponds with an Element; Earth, Air, Water & Fire. The Element corresponds with a season or a month and consequently each month corresponds with a Zodiac sign.

Tarot suit	Element
Cups suit	Water signs
Wands suit	Fire signs
Pentacles suit	Earth signs
Swords suit	Air signs

Zodiac sign

Pisces, Scorpio & Cancer Sagittarius, Leo & Aries Taurus, Virgo & Capricorn Aquarius, Libra & Gemini

Minor Arcana timing

Each element has a season/month & therefore we work on the timing of the month; below I have given you timing to work by.

Tarot suit

Swords (Air)

Wands (Fire)

Pentacles (Earth)

Timing

- within Days - within weeks Cups suit (Water) - within months
 - up to a year

Season or month

or during spring months (March/April/May) or during the summer months (June/July/Aug) or during the autumn months (Sept/Oct/Nov) or during winter months (Dec/Jan/Feb)

How does timing work in Tarot

Major Arcana timing

The Major Arcana timing is a little different & not all Majors will depict a time.

The Fool has no timing but works on the premise of "when you make the decision to start a new journey" similarly the Wheel of Fortune also works on the premise of "when the Universe decides its time"

With The Empress & Judgment also have no timing but work on the premise "surrounding cards" therefore look at the story being told across the card before & after one of these Major Arcana's.

The Fool	-	No timing
The Magician	-	No exact timing but quickly
The High Priestess	-	No timing
The Empress	-	Depends on surrounding cards
The Emperor	-	April
The Hierophant	-	April / May
The Lovers	-	May / June
The Chariot	-	June / July
Strength	-	July / August
The Hermit	-	August / September
The Wheel of Fortune	-	No exact time – any day
Justice	-	September / October
The Hanged Man	-	No exact timing – delays
Death	-	October / November
Temperance	-	November / December
The Devil	-	December / January
The Tower	-	Imminent & unexpected
The Star	-	January / February
The Moon	-	February / March
The Sun	-	During summer months
Judgement	-	Depends on surrounding cards
The World	-	Winter – delays likely
